

Photographic Kaleidoscopes

Photoshop Project #3


We will be creating kaleidoscopes out of our photos next week so you will need to have 3 photos taken! Make sure at least one is in black & white and one is in bright colors!








Low contrast images with very similar colors do not work very well for creating a kaleidoscope.






Images with very similar colors but higher contrast work a bit better.






Images with higher contrast and bright contrasting colors work much better for creating a kaleidoscope.















There are a lot of different kaleidoscopes that can be made from one image, so don't get hung up on a there being a "CORRECT" kaleidoscope. As long as your kaleidoscope is symmetrical and has 8 repetitions in it you are doing fine!



























Bright contrasting colors work really well in kaleidoscopes as they create areas of detail and interest.

You will need to take at least 1 photo using bright colors.



Patterns with some irregularities work really well for kaleidoscopes.


Take at least one black and white photo for this assignment!




Natural subjects, like plants, work really well because the individual stems and branches create lots of detail and areas of overlap.









Be careful about too much empty space in your photos. It will show up in your final kaleidoscope! This photo originally had lots of empty space in it.








Editing your photos BEFORE you turn them into kaleidoscopes is highly recommended!!! It will help you control the look and feel of your final work.
